

This policy complies with Sections 16056 or 16500.5 of the California Vehicle Code. Evidence of financial responsibility shall at all times be carried in the vehicle. Proof of insurance is required to register or renew the registration of your vehicle. A law enforcement officer can ask you to prove that you have liability insurance meeting the basic requirements of California law. A violation of these requirements can result in a fine of up to: \$1,000 for the first time \$2,000 for additional times. Also, a judge can have your vehicle impounded. False proof of insurance may result in a fine up to \$750 and 30 days in prison. Insurance information has already been submitted directly to the DMV electronically, submit this document to DMV only if specifically requested by DMV.

What to do at the time of an accident

- Stay at the scene in a safe location to exchange information
- If necessary, contact the police or call 911.
- Do not admit fault or reveal your coverage limits.
